The Photo Contest is always popular. There are two age groups for participation, Students in K- 12th grade and Adults. All types of photos, including color, black and white, digital, and film are acceptable. Contest entries will be on display at the Tioghnioga River Academy in Whitney Point on Saturday morning from 9:00 - 3:00. Winners will be announced and awards presented at 9:15 that morning. Cash prizes will be given for both age groups in each category. The deadline for photo entries is usually two weeks prior to Fall Festival to allow time for judging. So please plan accordingly and submit your photos on time. But, there's still time to take photos or identify up to three of your favorite photos and prepare them for the contest. Photo Contest entries can be dropped off at the Mary Wilcox Library or the Whitney Point High School main office. This would make a great family project. We'd love to see what you saw displayed at the Fall Festival Photo Exhibit!

The second contest that has become a Fall Festival favorite is the Baking Contest. Each entry must include King Arthur Flour as one of the ingredients. The theme changes each year, so check the contest rules for this year's requirements. This contest is open to bakers of all ages, youth and adult. The Youth age group includes children and students through 12th grade. Baked goods will be accepted in the Tioughnioga Riverside Academy cafeteria on Saturday morning from 10:00 - noon. Judging of baked goods will begin at 1:00. Winners will be announced and prizes awarded upon completion of the judging. There are lots of prizes!
